All 4-H BC members are eligible. The contest is for the 2020 PNE only, categories are **5618 Junior** (4-H ages 9-11), **5619 Intermediate** (4-H ages 12-14), **5620 Senior/Club*** (4-H ages 15+ or group of any age).

*All educational displays created by more than one person will be entered in the Senior/Club category, regardless of participant age.

In addition to the displays, there will be an educational seminar on Monday August 24, 2020. Attendance is mandatory for all participants unless competing with other projects at that time.

If this competition cannot be run in person due to restrictions on public gathering, it will be completed online. If the competition is moved online, deadlines will be extended to allow participation by members who would not otherwise have been able to participate due to lack of availability to attend the PNE.
