## Photography Contest 2022

### Who is eligible?

The Photography Contest is open to 4-H age groups, adults and 4-H Alumni! Photographs should revolve around four leadership pillars of 4-H (see previous page for topic suggestions). We are accepting up to 3 photo entries for each member or adult. The winning photos will also be featured in the 2023 4-H BC Calendar.

### Judging Criteria

Entries will be evaluated on the following criteria:

1. Creativity/style and originality
2. Photographic composition, focus & exposure
3. Overall presentation

Entries will be judged in four categories:

1. Junior Members
2. Senior Members
3. Adults (leaders & parents)
4. 4-H Alumni

### Prizes

**1<sup>st</sup> place** in each category will receive a \$100 cash prize.

**2<sup>nd</sup> place** in each category will receive a \$75 cash prize.

**3<sup>rd</sup> place** in each category will receive a \$50 cash prize.

### To Enter

**To enter the contest, you must be a current 4-H member, leader, parent or 4-H Alumni.** ALL 4-H British Columbia members, leaders, parents and 4-H Alumni are eligible to enter (you do NOT have to be in the Photography project).

1. Submit the registration page included in this registration booklet to Yana at [communications@bc4h.bc.ca](mailto:communications@bc4h.bc.ca)
2. Once you have submitted, you will be emailed a link and a code to 4-H BC's SmugMug page where you can upload your photo(s). Smug Mug will prompt you for the code once you follow the link.

**IMPORTANT-** To ensure we know it's your submission, please name your file in the following format (**Please note: pictures not labeled in this manner will not be accepted**):

*If you are submitting more than one photo to the contest, please number your photos with an additional underscore from 1-3, and ensure they correspond with the correct numbers on your registration form.*

**Example:** Bernardi\_Lauren\_1.jpg

Bernardi\_Lauren\_2.jpg

Bernardi\_Lauren\_3.jpg

Please ensure the name on your photo is the same as the one in your registration form, so we can identify you.

## Rules

- Each member or adult can enter **up to 3 photos**. Please refer to page 1 for **Photo Suggestions**. Photos may be digitally edited, if the photographer wishes! Retouch is appreciated but not necessary.
- No late entries will be accepted. The contest runs from **June 1st, 2022 to September 15th, 2022**.
- All photographs must have been taken by 4-H BC Photography Contest participants between January 1st, 2022 and September 15th, 2022.
- Size of Photo: Photos submitted should be at least 1000 pixels by 800 pixels (**landscape**) and saved as a JPEG or PNG.
- The photos must be in focus.
- The ideal 10x8 quality is 3000 pixels by 2400 pixels, which is the same as an 10x8 photo at 300 dpi (resolution).
- Any higher variations of the 10x8 ratio are allowed.

If your photos have a different pixel ratio you may still submit. However the photos will be judged using the 10x8 pixel dimensions. Which may cause your photo to appear stretched, compressed, or distorted. If you view a photo's properties on your computer it will tell you the width and height in pixels. Entries will be judged on presentation, lighting, composition and creativity.

**Photo's become the property of 4-H British Columbia for promotional use on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, website and the 4-H British Columbia calendar.** Make sure you have permission when photographing people. Submitting your photo confirms you agree to these terms.

**The deadline to submit photos is September 15, 2022.**

*Please be careful when taking your pictures and be aware of your surroundings at all times.*
