In conjunction with their participation in 4-H Alberta's provincial Sheep Show, members may also register to participate in Summer Synergy components and compete for Summer Synergy scholarships. Am I Eligible?

This show is open to all registered 4-H Sheep project members in good standing with their clubs. Placing at previous shows has no bearing on entries at the 4-H Alberta Sheep Show.

How Much Does It Cost?

Program Early Bird Registration Fee \$75.00 (April 1 – May 15)

Program Registration Fee \$100.00 (May 16 – June 1)

When is the Application Deadline?

Registration is open until June 1, 2019 inclusive.

Provincial Event Registration Policies

- Registration is not considered complete until full payment is received.
- All requests for registration after the deadline will be accepted at the sole discretion of the program lead and will be subject to an additional fee of \$50.00.
- An administrative fee of **\$50.00** will be retained on all **cancellations**. Cancellations received less than 14 days before the event start date will forfeit the entire registration fee unless a delegate replacement is available or extenuating circumstances are at play.
