

# 4-H BC 2018 LEADERS' & KEY LEADERS' CONFERENCE



Hello to all 4-H BC leaders! We welcome you to the 2018 Provincial 4-H Leaders' Conference "Leaning into Leadership", hosted October 12<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> at the Coast Hotel in Kamloops. Key Leader training will be hosted from 9am to 3pm on Friday, October 12<sup>th</sup>. Leaders' Conference events will run from 6:00pm on Friday until 12:00pm on Sunday, October 14<sup>th</sup>. **Registration deadline is September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018.**

Channel your inner flannel for our Lumber Jack & Jill themed conference, including our Friday night welcome team building activities. Saturday and Sunday sessions will include round tables, breakout sessions, a choose your own adventure field trip and large group presentations on topics including dealing with change, 4-H Canada opportunities, and youth mental health. Be sure to bring some spending money so you can bid on items in our famous Leaders' Conference silent auction and pick up supplies at our onsite 4-H store.

*How does your attitude affect your community?* This year, we are very excited to welcome Doug Griffiths (<https://www.13ways.ca/>) as our Saturday keynote presenter. In a unique and humorous presentation, Griffiths will be challenging your idea of what community means and encourage you to discover your role within your own neighborhood.

Conference fee of \$250 includes double occupancy accommodation, meals, Northern and Southern charter bus as well as conference events. Special rates for single occupancy or without accommodation are also listed in the attached conference registration form.

Key Leader training is free of charge for Key Leaders, and includes Thursday night accommodation at the hotel as well as breakfast and lunch on Friday. **A – Club Management**

- In this session leaders will learn tools to help manage their club in a way that involves members and supports them to reach their highest potential. Participants in this session will receive credit towards their 4-H Leader Training 4-H Basics Certificate.

**B – Judging**

- This session will help leaders teach 4-H judging skills to members, evaluate judging skills including placings and reasons, and plan 4-H judging events. Participants in this session will receive credit towards their 4-H Leader Training 4-H Program Delivery Certificate.

**C – Emergency Preparedness**

- This session will focus on what role the Province of British Columbia plays in the event of an emergency, as well as what should be done to best prepare for an emergency. There will be an emphasis on managing livestock, particularly for those who are small-scale producers or hobbyists.

**D – Proudly Presenting Agriculture**

- In this session leaders will learn how to become ambassadors for agriculture and animal care. The session will touch on how to deal with difficult conversations at fairs and other public events, as well as how to handle animal rights activists.
