



Details:

- New 4-H Clubs starting in 2022-2023 enrolment year are eligible for a grant to cover their first year start-up expenses.
- Grants will be in the amount needed to cover Provincial Assessment fees for all members and leaders of the new club, plus \$25 per person for supplies. Grants do not include payment of District fees.
- Grants would be disbursed on a first come first served basis, until allotted funds have been used up.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Clubs must be in their first year of operation - new clubs resulting from a group splitting off of an existing club are not eligible.
- Only new members and new leaders, never previously enrolled, are eligible for grant funds.
- Members and leaders must complete online enrolment prior to applying for their grant. No fee payment at time of registration is required.

Steps:

1. Register New Club by contacting 4-H BC at [1-866-776-0373](tel:1-866-776-0373) or volunteersupport@4hbc.ca
2. Club leaders must complete screening process and enroll online
3. Club members must enroll online
4. The club must open an account at a bank or credit union
5. Complete the required details on the back of this form and submit to volunteersupport@4hbc.ca
6. Fees will be paid directly to 4-H BC for all listed members and leaders who have completed their online enrolment
7. A cheque for \$25 per enrolled member and leader will be mailed to the club
