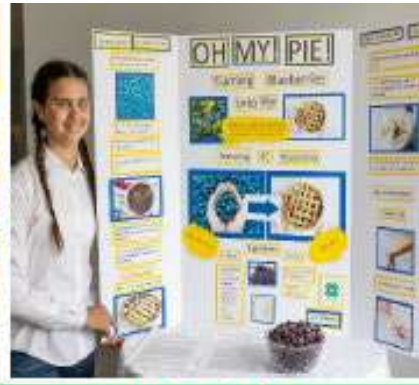


## 2022 4-H BC Special Topic Educational Display Contest Winners

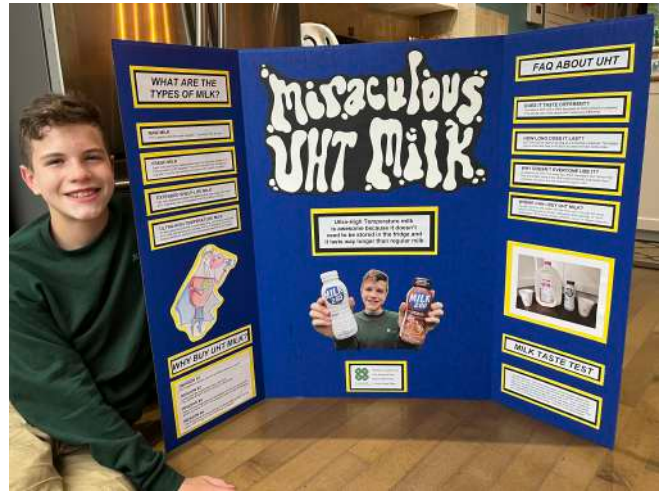

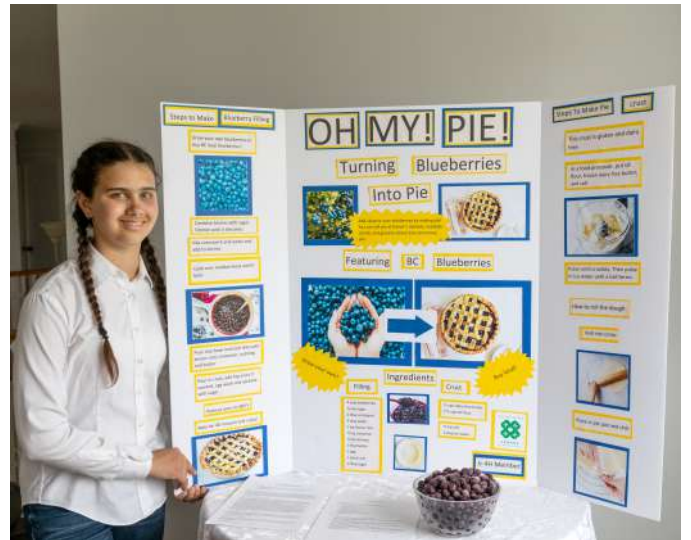
