Provincial 4-H Program Cancellation Policy

- If cancelling, delegates who notify the 4-H BC Office in writing during the period of 30 days to 7 days prior to program start date will receive 50% registration fee refund
- Delegates, who cancel within 7 days of the program start date, fail to notify in writing or fail to attend the program, will receive no refund.

This experience is a six day program for 4-H members and non 4-H students to explore careers in the agriculture industry. Most of the program takes place on a charter bus to allow for agriculture tour stops in different regions of BC. Participants will get to see and experience first-hand the diversity of agriculture in BC and the careers available in the industry. There is a career building component where participants learn how to market themselves through resume, interview and networking skills. Opportunity Commitment:

The 4-H BC Ambassadors promote awareness of 4-H opportunities in their region and around the province, and act as resource people for 4-H members, leaders and the public. Participants attend one training session a year and participate in up to three conference calls. Ambassadors are required to have a leading role in at least 10 different activities in their region during the year. There are a total of 20 Ambassadors to represent

4-H in BC each year, however only 10 will be selected annually (for a two year term).
