# How to Become a Cloverbud

All Cloverbud members are registered 4-H members and must complete the club registration process. Cloverbud members are assessed the current year's club registration fees and are covered by 4-H BC's insurance.

Cloverbuds can enroll in any registered 4-H club that is offering the Cloverbud project. This may be a community club with several projects or a specialized club just for Cloverbuds.

# Starting a Cloverbud Club

If you're interested in starting a club in your area, you will need to become a registered 4-H leader. Contact 4-H BC for more information.

There are two options for starting new Cloverbud groups:

- 1. Join an existing 4-H club as a new leader guiding the Cloverbud project.
- 2. Start a brand new Cloverbud club as long as you have a minimum of 6 members.

# Who can be a 4-H Cloverbud?




### UNIT 2 - 6 to 8 year olds

- Cloverbud members are eligible for a 4-H Achievement Certificate and a 4-H Cloverbud Unit Badge.
- The Cloverbud project is a minimum of six months long.

## UNIT 4 - for 8 year olds
